

# Victoria Falls Marathon Half Marathon & 7.5k

June 29 – July 7, 2021

## **Monday, June 28:**

Depart hometown on international flight to Victoria Falls, Africa.

## **Tuesday, June 29:**

Arrive at Victoria Falls Airport and transfer to The Kingdom Hotel, rest and recover from your long flight.

## **Wednesday, June 30:**

Day of leisure, rest and explore the area.

## **Thursday, July 1:**

After breakfast at our hotel we venture out to see the one of the most beautiful waterfalls in the world, Victoria Falls a UNESCO World Heritage Site also known by the indigenous as “The Smoke That Thunders”. While it is neither the highest nor the widest waterfall in the world, Victoria Falls is classified as the largest based on its combined width of 5,604 ft and height of 354 ft, resulting in the world’s largest sheet of falling water. Victoria Falls is roughly twice the height of the North America’s Niagara Falls and over twice the width of its Horseshoe Falls.

This evening we will enjoy a Boma dinner, an unforgettable African experience infused with Zimbabwean cuisine, spirited performances and traditional storytelling.

## **Friday, July 2:**

After breakfast at our hotel we head out on a game drive in Zambezi National Park. A wide variety of larger mammals may be found within the Zambezi National Park including elephant, lion, buffalo and leopard, in addition herds of sable antelope, eland, zebra, giraffe, kudu, waterbuck and impala as well as

many of smaller species of game can be viewed. The Zambezi River is home to over 75 species of fish and famous for its bream and fighting tiger fish. Evening at leisure.
